Alan Fairchild MBE, FSLCC, Honorary Vice President SLCC

Alan Fairchild MBE, SLCC Honorary Vice-President & Cemetery Management Trainer will review changes being introduced by burial authorities to increase memorialisation re-cycling and encourage more seasonal grave planting and cemetery landscaping. Alan will also discuss the likely impact of DEFRA's updated Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 to ensure burials in existing and new cemeteries and extensions do not cause pollution of surface and ground water which are expected to be introduced later this year.

Community Resilience & Emergency Planning.

Richard Herrrell: Norfolk Fire & Rescue.

The Norfolk Resilience Forum (NRF) is a multi-agency partnership that works with emergency responders, parishes and communities to prepare for, respond to and recover from emergencies such as flooding. Through our Stronger Resilient Communities Programme, we are working with communities to help them identify, mitigate and prepare for risks they may face starting with the introduction of a cascade systems to engage with communities potentially at risk. Different communities will face different risks, many of which will be exacerbated by climate change. Preparing and planning for these risks is fairly simple: know the risks, be informed and get prepared. This session will be delivered by members of the NRF including emergency planners and Norfolk Fire and Rescue Service.
