Anglian Water is currently in the process of installing a new foul water pipeline from Castle Acre Water Recycling Centre to Swaffham. The entire route is approximately 5.5km in length and so far we have installed approximately 4km. We will soon begin to start work at the junction of **South Acre Road and A1065**. The work will commence on **16th September 2019** and some traffic management measures (traffic lights) will be in place during these works and a road closure will come into effect.

The work will be carried out between the **16th September 2019 and 27th September 2019** (Monday – Friday 07:30 – 18:00).

It will not impact on the use of your facilities and there will be no loss of services. However, there will be traffic management restrictions in place.

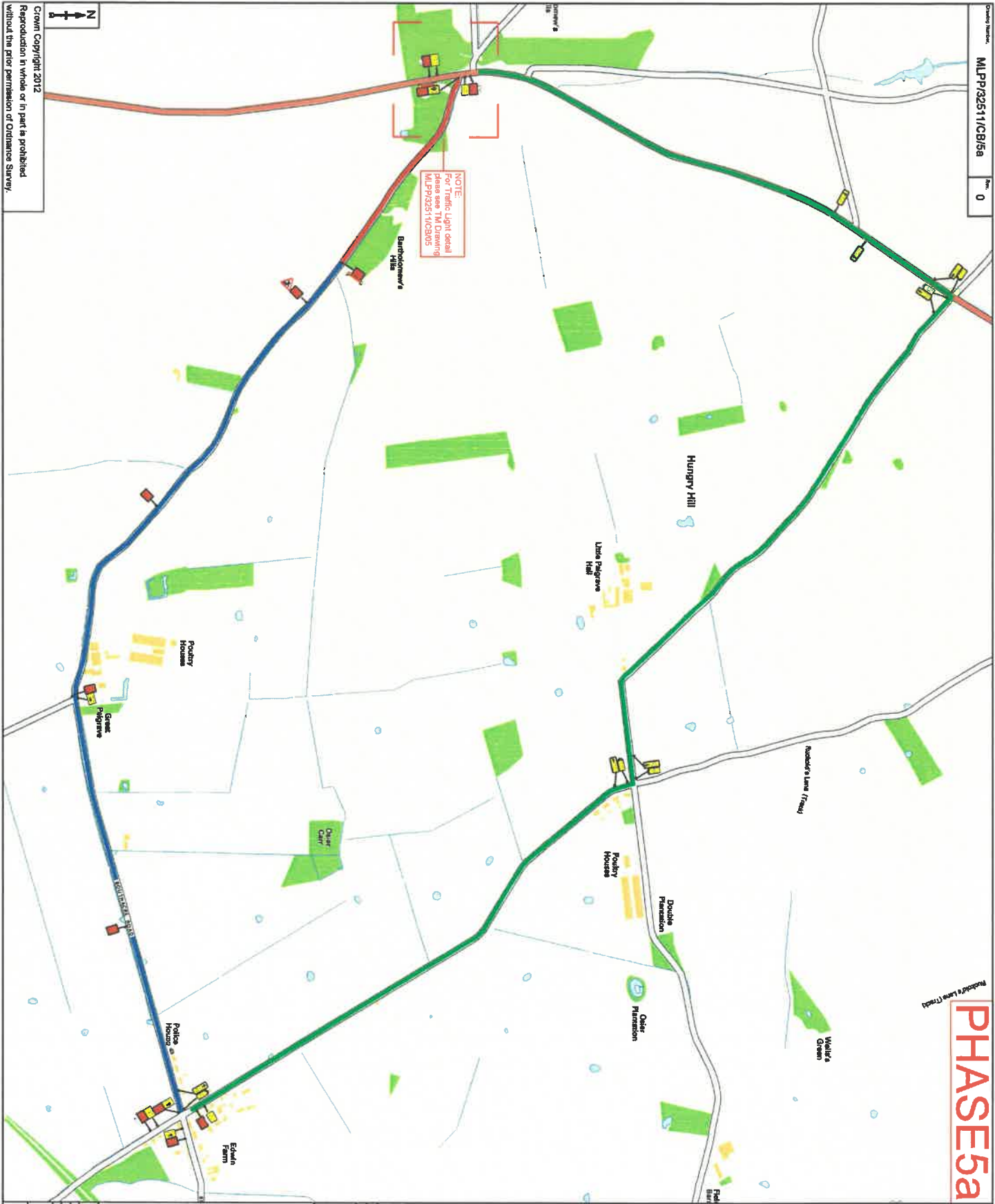
