Re. Carriageway resurfacing works- Mangate Street, Swaffham.

We will be carrying out resurfacing works on 23 January 2019 (weather permitting). To protect the safety of the public and our workforce, works will be carried out under four-way stop/go boards. There will be two temporary crossing points installed with lights to ensure pedestrian traffic can cross the road safely. Furthermore, access to the George Hotel will be maintained off Mangate Street (plan below shows). Additionally, the traffic lights will be bagged up and the crossing points will be suspended to allow the works to progress effectively.

Funding for this scheme is from the extra £12.694m Norfolk County Council has received from the Government to spend on road maintenance in 2018/19. This money is Norfolk's share of the £420m, made available to local authorities in England, which was announced in the Budget on 29 October 2018.

The work which will cost £11,750 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
