Hi Lorraine

Thank you for your enquiry which has been forwarded to me by Swaffham town council.

Northwell Pool Road is a 30mph road. I am not sure which 20mph sign you are referring to, as even the side roads are also 30mph? I have however programmed for the double yellow lines to be refreshed so this will enhance the parking restrictions and make them clearer for drivers. The parking restrictions on the west side are for a distance of 71 metres and on the east side for a distance of 103 metres only, not the whole length.

The refreshment works will likely be carried out in the spring of next year as unfortunately all of our lining budget has been committed for this season.

Contraventions of either the one-way or the speed limits are the responsibility of the police.

I trust the above information is useful.

I am hoping you will be able to help us all here at Northwell Place by placing a speed sign, 20 mph, on Northwell Pool Road.

It is dangerous the speed in which drivers, cars and delivery vans, drive up and down Northwell Pool Road, even though it is clearly signed as one way, and onto

Northwell Place.

My residents here are too frail to run/jump out of the way and in the past I have seen cars mount pavements and verges as they were driving too fast to avoid or stop.

Depending on when you visit us the road in question can be very busy during the week as drivers use Northwell Pool Road as a short cut due to the hospital road being so congested.

Saturdays is an eye opener as every man and his dog park on Northwell Pool Road blocking entrances and lowered pavements and Sundays it is obviously extremely busy with the church.

When I first moved here there were double yellow lines all the way down on the left hand side of the road, this can still be seen through the worn road surface, and a 20mph sign. All of which have been removed!?

Please point me in the right direction if you are unable to help us and I thank you for your time.
