1. The Order

This allows the Traffic Authority (Norfolk County Council) to temporarily restrict or prohibit the use of a road and/or footpath.

2. The 'Propose To' Notice (PT)

This is the public Notice we must advertise at least seven days before making an Order.

3. The 'Has Made' Notice (HM)

This is the public Notice we must advertise within 14 days of making an Order.

Please note a new format is being introduced and for those looking for the plan, if a separate one is not attached, it can now be found on page 2 of the notices.

The proposed order comes into effect on the date shown. The date on the notices is when they will appear in the Eastern Daily Press. If we have to change any dates, we will let you know. NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) B1145 Lynn Road from its junction with the A1065 Fakenham Road to its junction with the C236 Rougham Road; and 2) B1145 Litcham Road from its junction with the C236 Rougham Road for a distance of 600 metres eastwards; in the PARISH OF ROUGHAM because of carriageway resurfacing works.

The roads 1) and 2) will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 9<sup>th</sup> January 2019 to 25<sup>th</sup> January 2019 for the duration of the works, expected to be 17 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: B1145 Litcham Road, B1153 East Walton Road/ Gayton Road, A47, A1065 Castleacre Road, Road from Swaffham To Weasenham All Saints, Fakenham Road  
(Pentney/ Gayton/ Swaffham/ Sporle with Palgrave/ South Acre/ Newton By Castle Acre/ Lexham/ East Walton/ Rougham/ Great Massingham).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

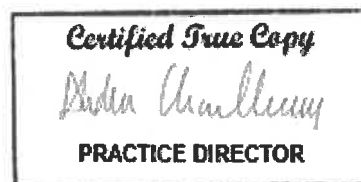

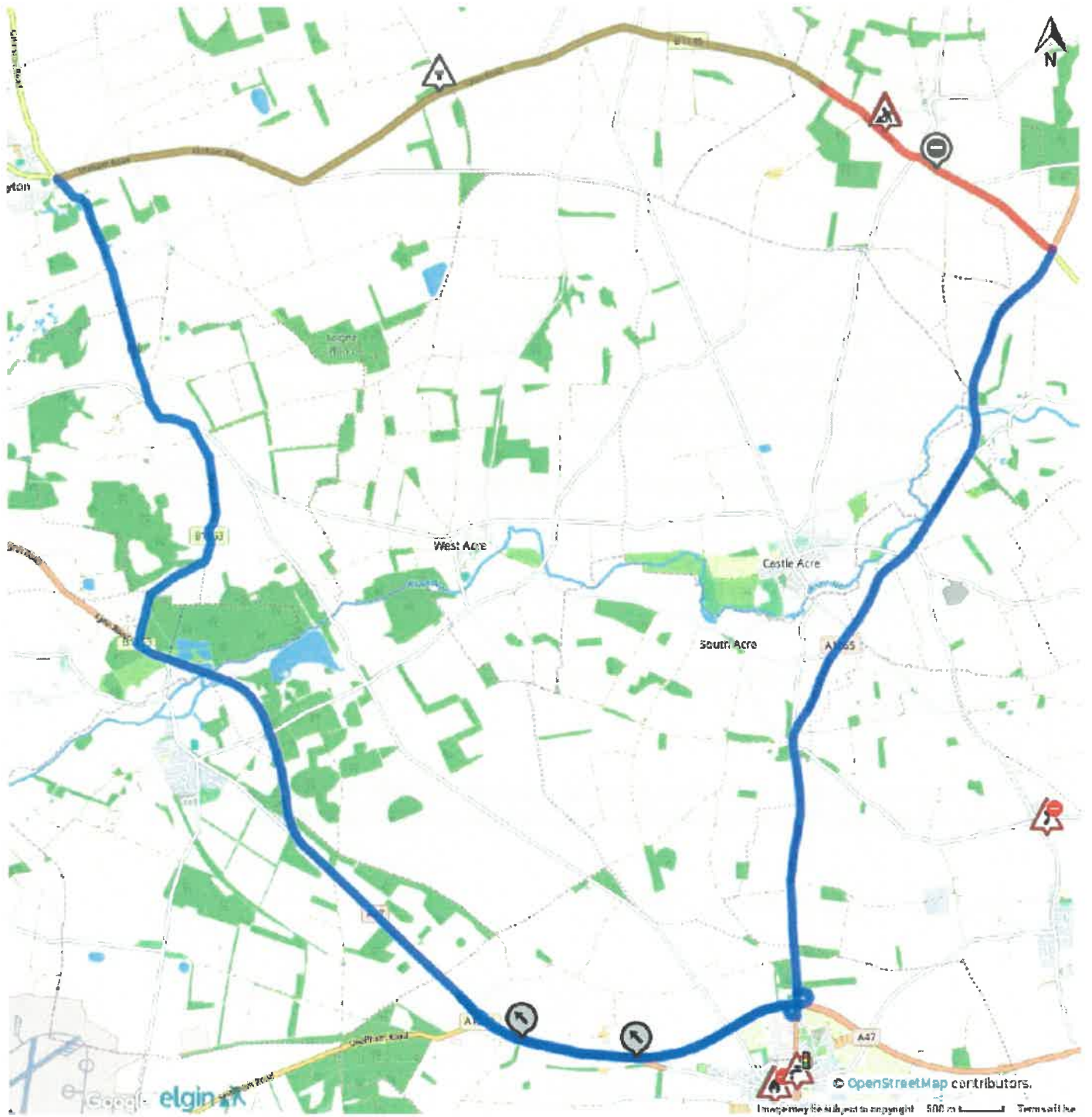

**NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL  
(ROUGHAM)  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2019  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)**

ORDER prohibiting the use by vehicles of:-

- 1) B1145 Lynn Road from its junction with the A1065 Fakenham Road to its junction with the C236 Rougham Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (a)) and:
- 2) B1145 Litcham Road from its junction with the C236 Rougham Road for a distance of 600 metres eastwards (hereinafter referred to as the said road (b));

in the PARISH OF ROUGHAM

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that carriageway resurfacing is required at the said roads (a) and (b) and that in consequence traffic over the said roads (a) and (b) should be prohibited with effect from 9<sup>th</sup> January 2019 to 25<sup>th</sup> January 2019 for the duration of the works, expected to be 17 days within the period.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
3. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

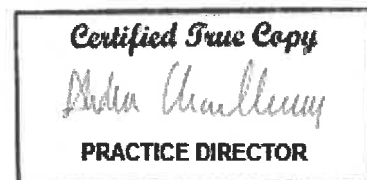
NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 9<sup>th</sup> January 2019 to 25<sup>th</sup> January 2019 for the duration of the works the said road SHALL NOT BE USED by any class of vehicle.
