At the next Full Council Meeting on Wednesday 11 September, please can we have an opportunity to discuss LITTER - Bins and collections/responsibilities.

Litter around our streets is embarrassing and detrimental. I am advised also that there are insufficient BINS on the Redlands site and also on London Street between Town and the residential area. This results in much Litter (especially food cartons) being thrown aside as consumers walk home with their 'meals'. I have mentioned previously the re-siting of a Litter Bin to the North East corner of Market place - adjacent Premier Travel/Costa Coffee or thereabouts - from across the road, where there are sufficient bins and we need to avoid the need to cross (for responsible citizens) for disposal.

On Saturdays, the 'Burger' stall does provide a bin and that is very welcome.
