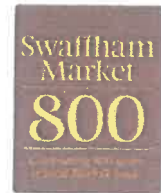

It is also possible that some of the expenses straddle two financial years, so it might be difficult to find every item. We will pull the information together in one place and give you the up-to-date figure to date in the next couple of weeks. I don't suppose you have an e-mail address that I could use, to send this to you?

Thank you for your comments in respect of the Christmas Lights, unfortunately we have had two of these new lights fail over the Christmas period, but the public comments have been very positive overall – it is good to get feedback in this regard.
